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Groom’s [summary](#) of the Department of Labor’s (“DOL”) proposed procedure to collect data from plan administrators in an effort to comply with the SECURE 2.0 provision requiring the DOL to establish a database where individuals can locate their retirement benefits was cited in the *PLANSPONSOR* article, “DOL Asks for Participant Information to Build Lost and Found Database.”
